WHEN EVENING HAD COME, HE SAT DOWN WITH THE TWELVE. 21 NOW AS THEY WERE EATING, HE SAID, "ASSUREDLY, I SAY TO YOU, ONE OF YOU WILL BETRAY ME." 22 AND THEY WERE EXCEEDINGLY SORROWFUL, AND EACH OF THEM BEGAN TO SAY TO HIM, "LORD, IS IT I?" 23 HE ANSWERED AND SAID, "HE WHO DIPPED HIS HAND WITH ME IN THE DISH WILL BETRAY ME. 24 THE SON OF MAN INDEED GOES JUST AS IT IS WRITTEN OF HIM, BUT WOE TO THAT MAN BY WHOM THE SON OF MAN IS BETRAYED! 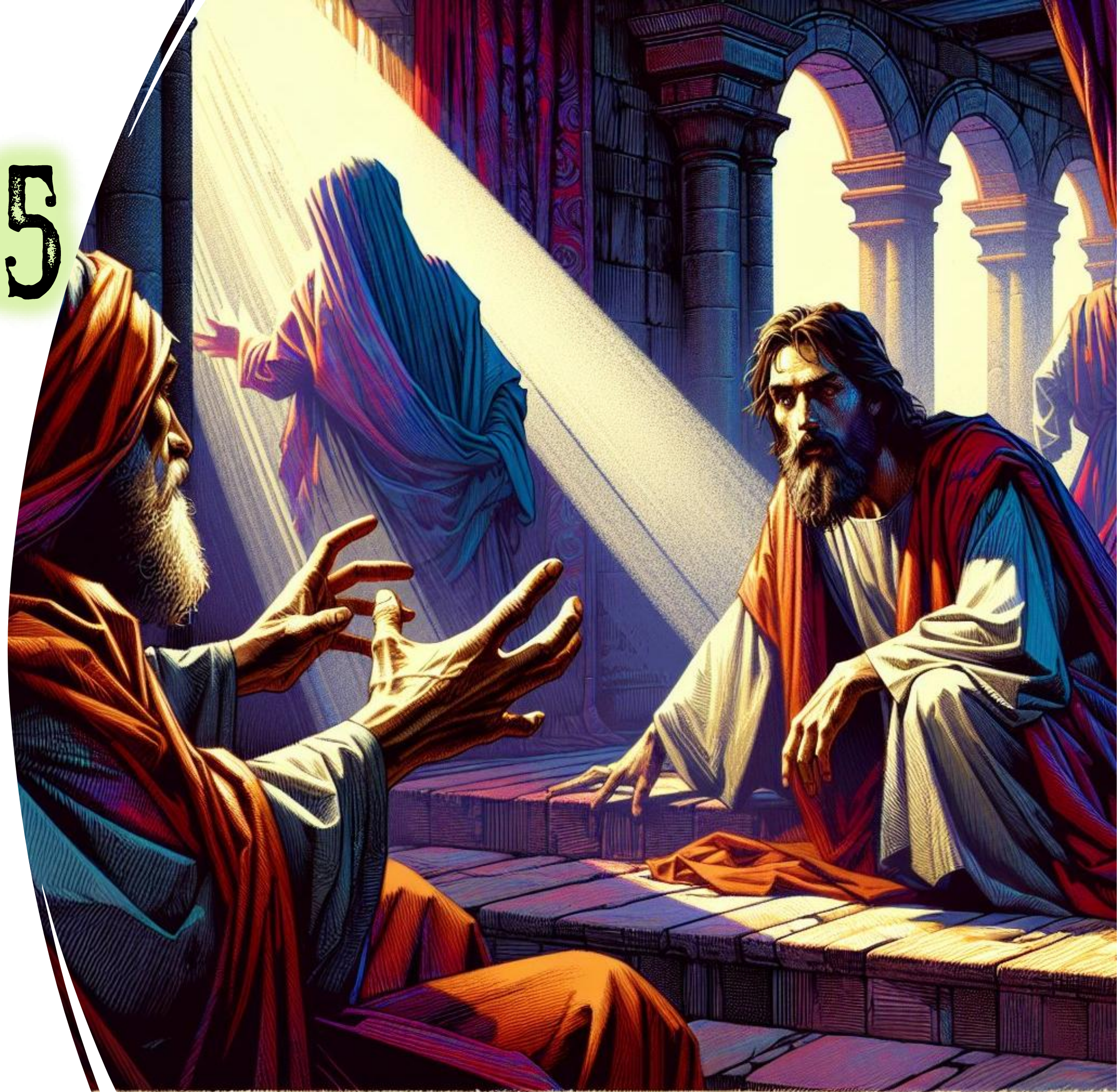

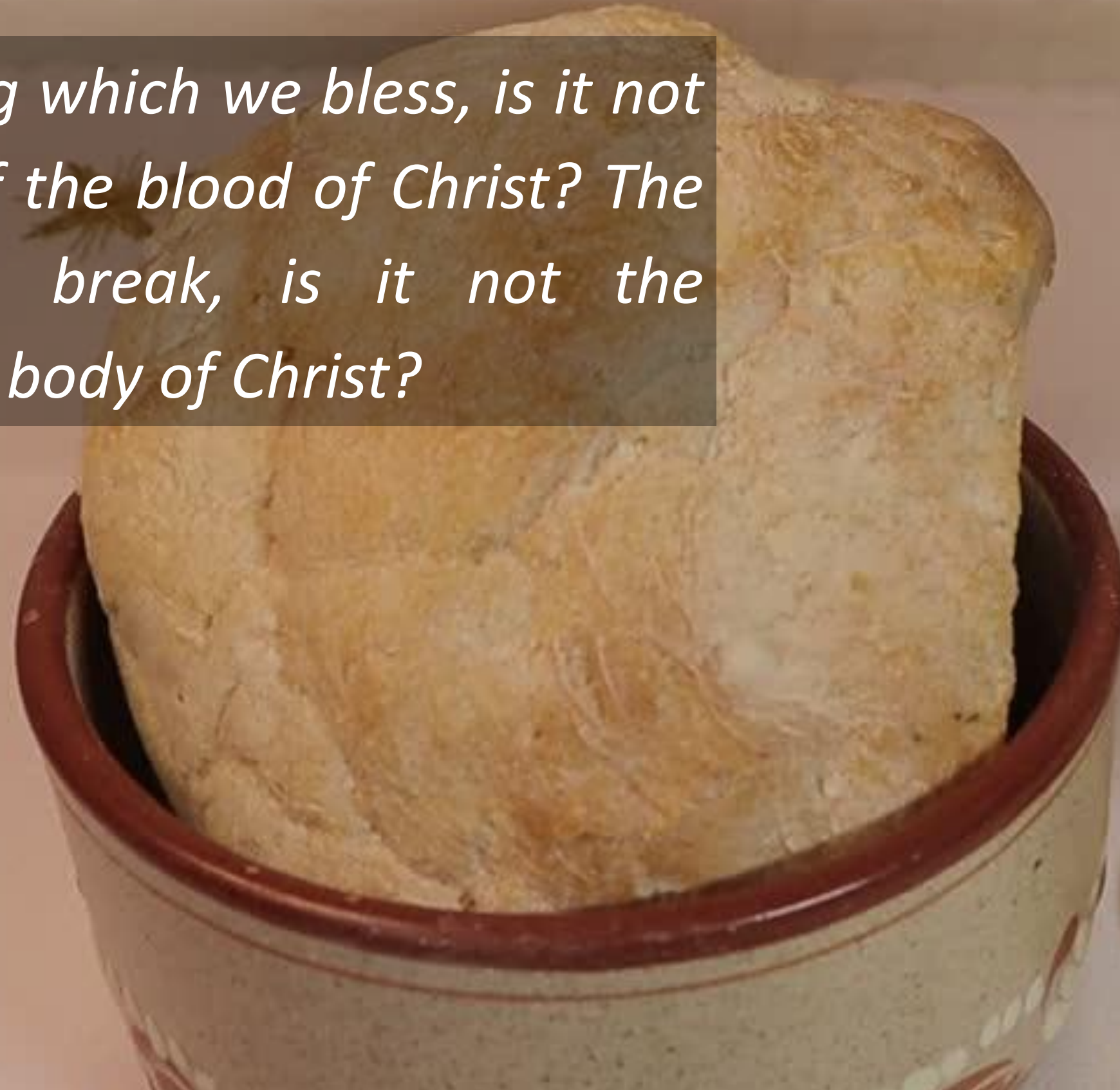
