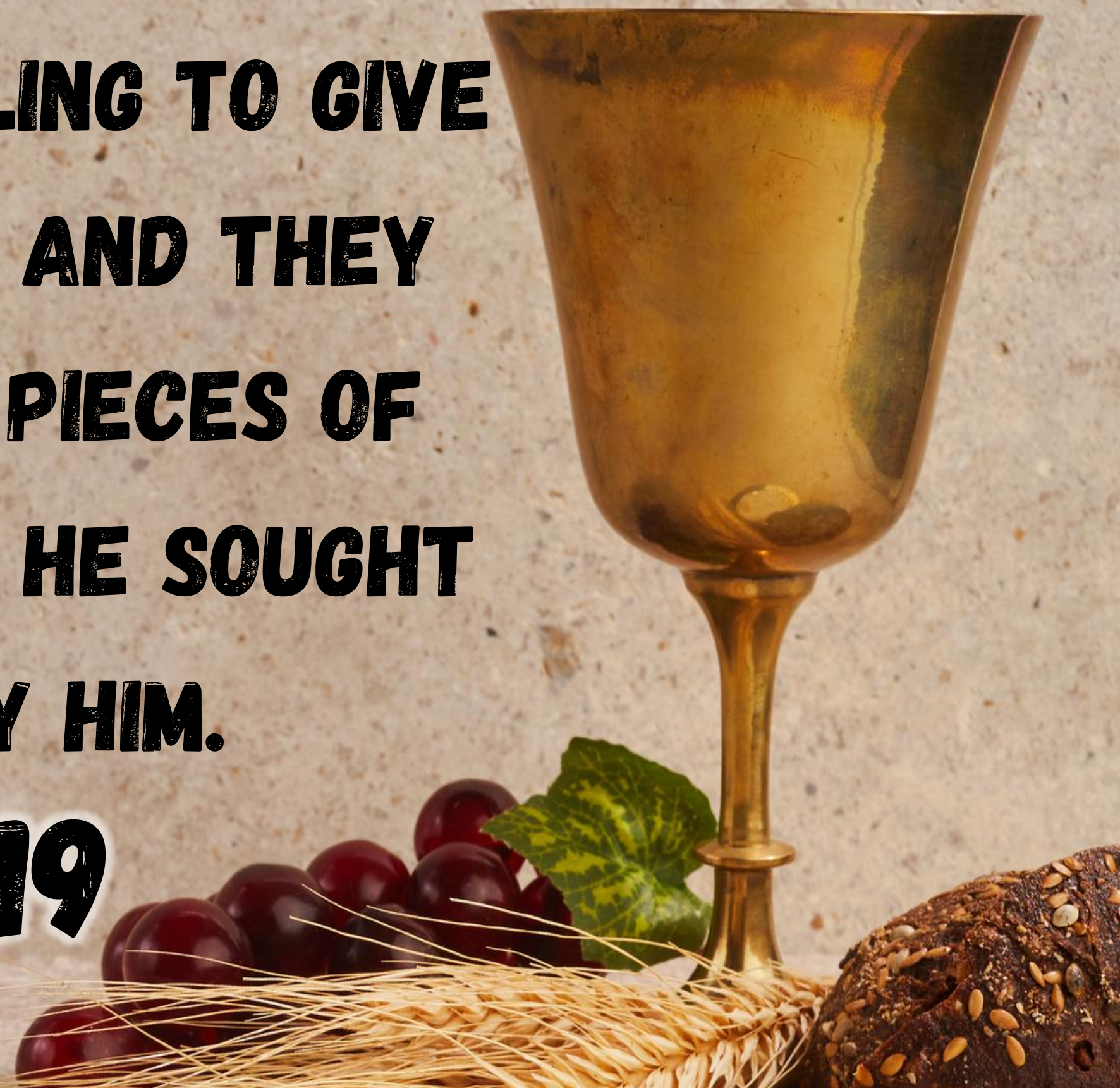


LAST PASSOVER OF JESUS

Leviticus 23:6

Exodus 12:18-20

In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at evening, you shall eat unleavened bread, until the twenty-first day of the month at evening. ¹⁹ For seven days no leaven shall be found in your houses, since whoever eats what is leavened, that same person shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he is a stranger or a native of the land. ²⁰ You shall eat nothing leavened; in all your dwellings you shall eat unleavened bread.' ”

❑ The **Galileans**, the northern people, and the Pharisees, counted the day from sunrise to sunrise, the day of **Passover**.

❑ Whereas the **Judean** and **Sadducees** counted the day of **Passover** from sunset to sunset.





Tuesday, the Galileans and the Pharisees begin to calculate the beginning of Passover in the morning to the next morning which is Wednesday morning.



WEDNESDAY

The Judeans and the Sadducees don't begin until Tuesday evening at sunset, and it runs till Wednesday evening at sunset.
