How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! 38 See! Your house is left to you desolate; 39 for I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say, ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!’ ”.

All the Favorite people in our life are Jewish.





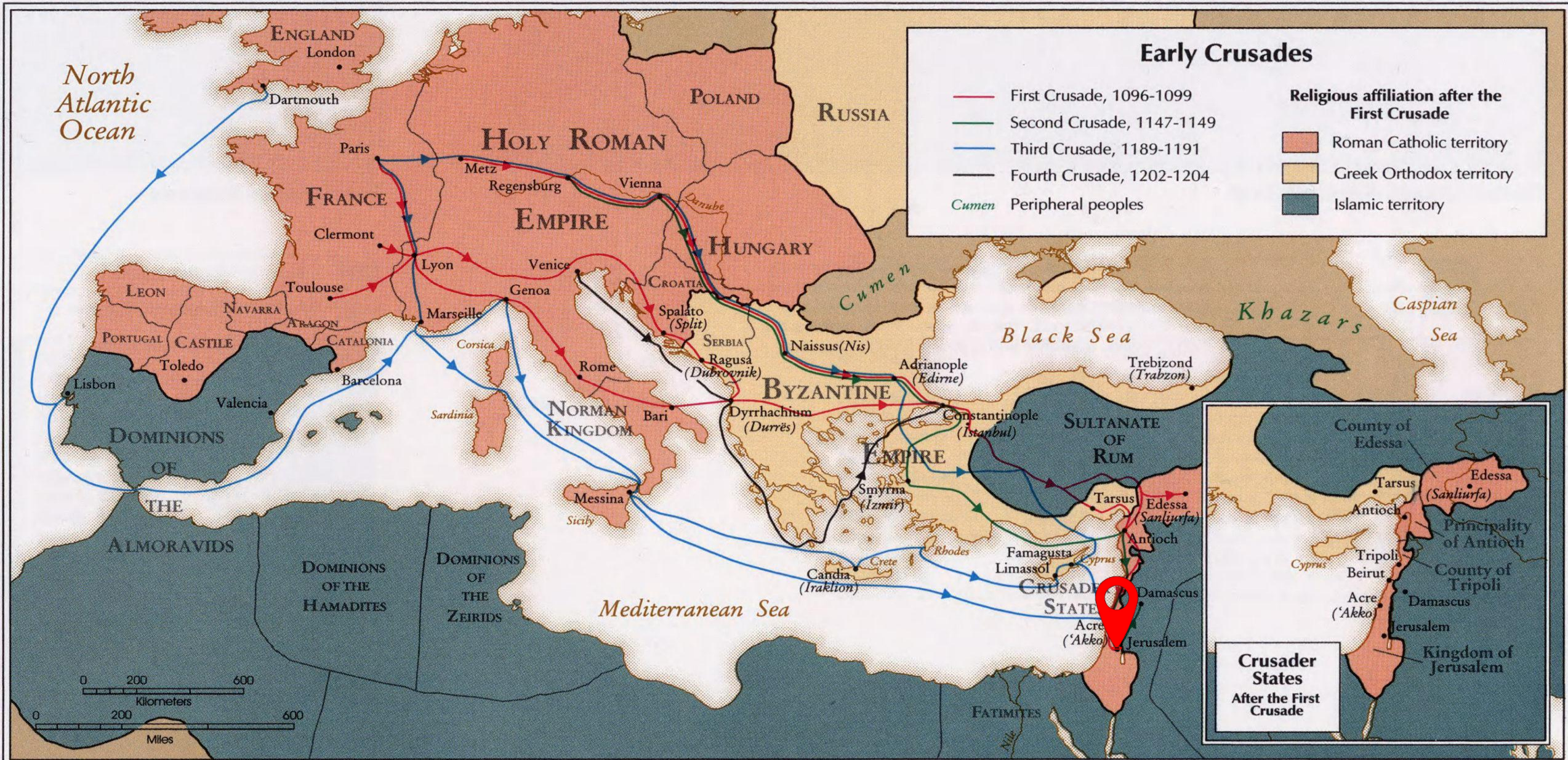
**1,100,000 dead Jews, 100,000 Jews were taken as prisoners.

King and queen **Ferdinand and Isabella**, who were the same two in power commissioning **Columbus to sail**,




Across Europe Jews became known as

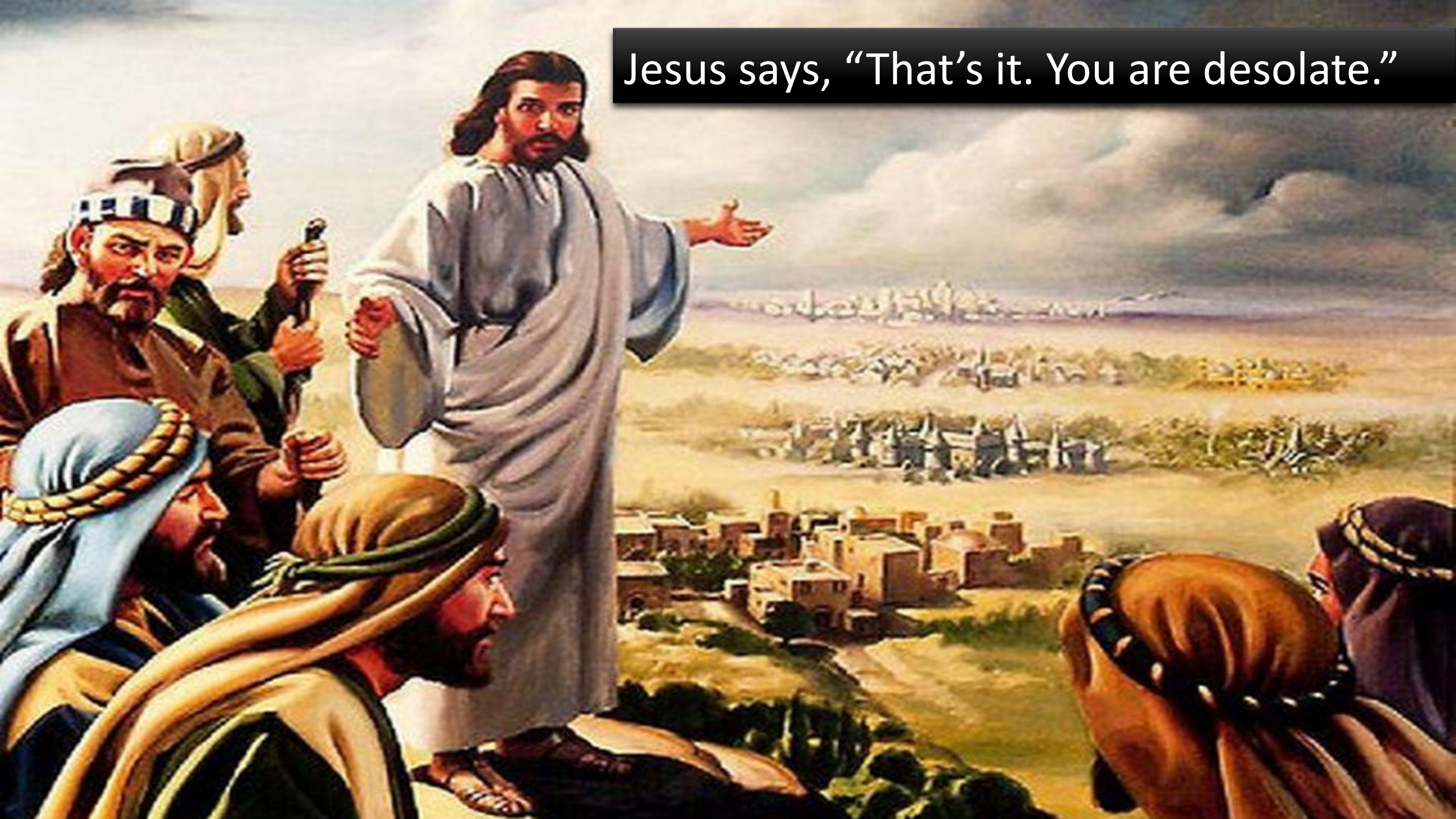
