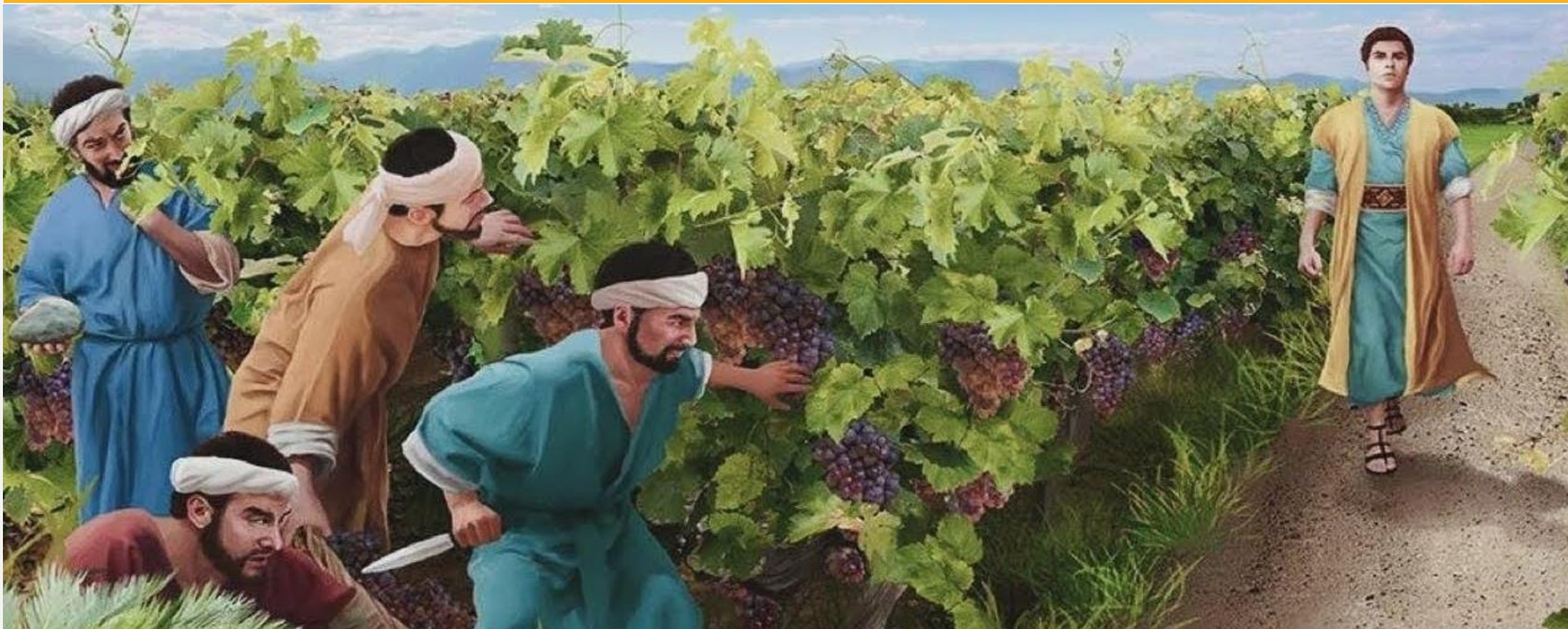

And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another.

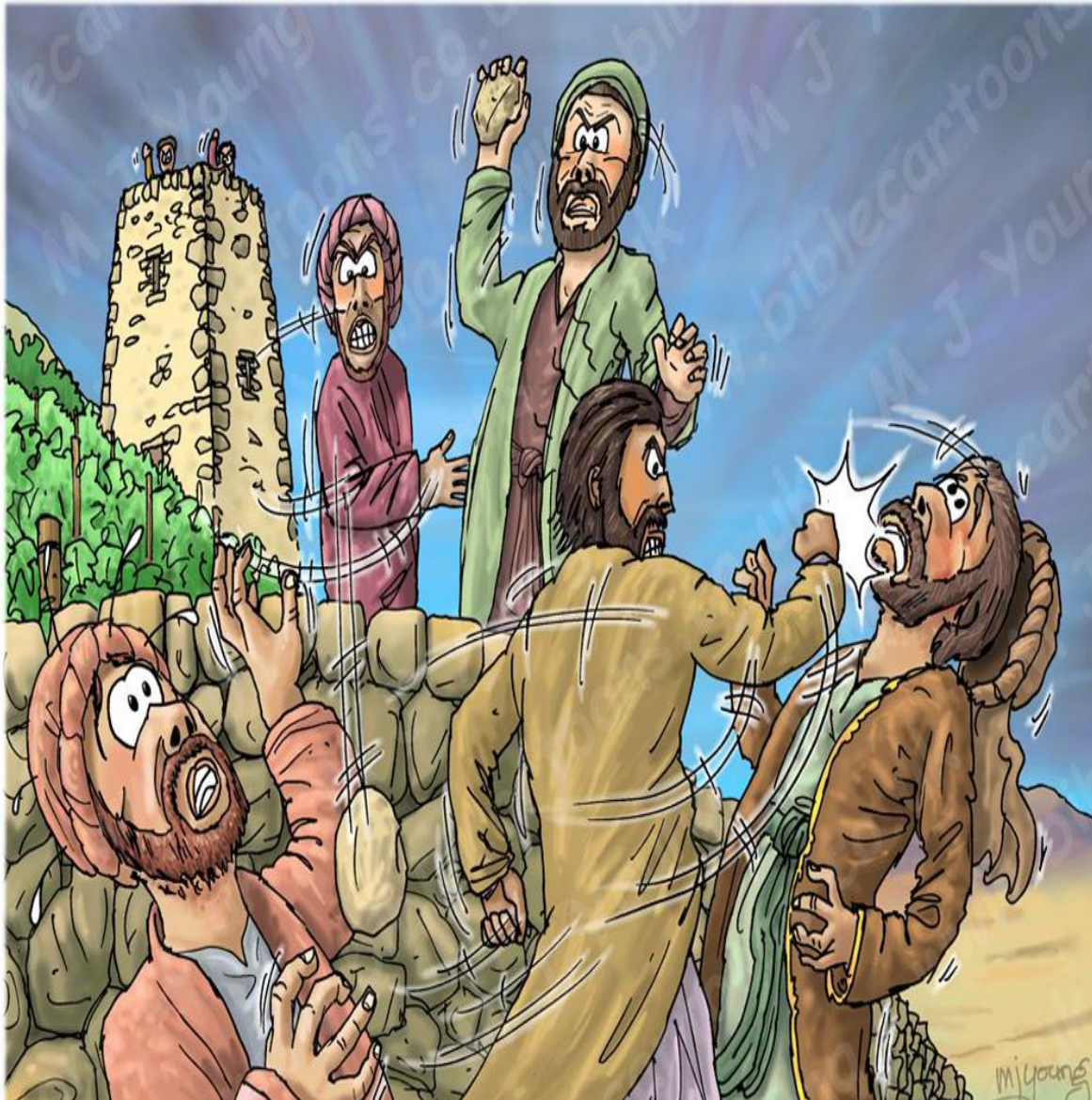
Story/ Parable.

- Next one came; they **stoned** him.

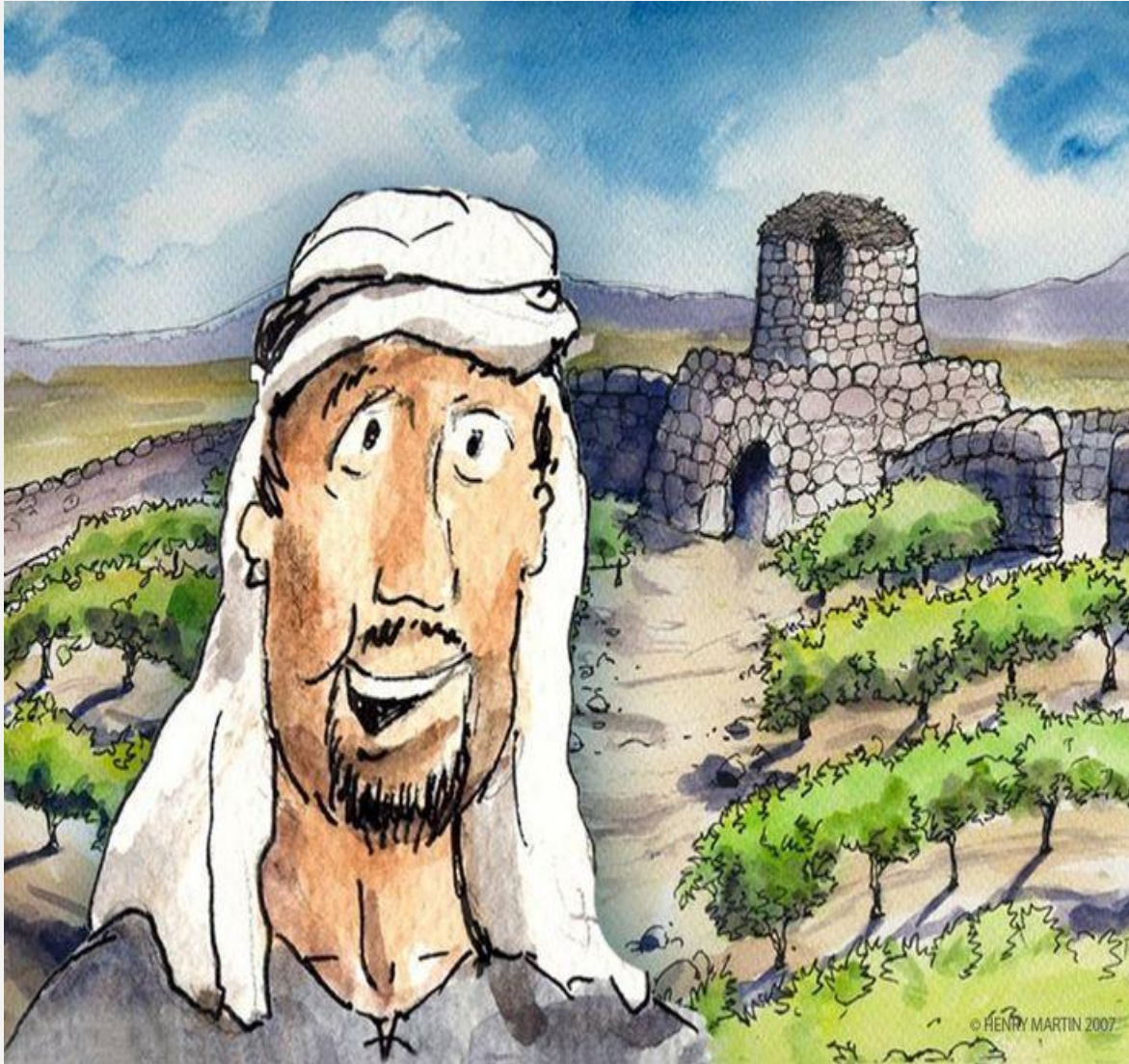


MATTHEW 21:36

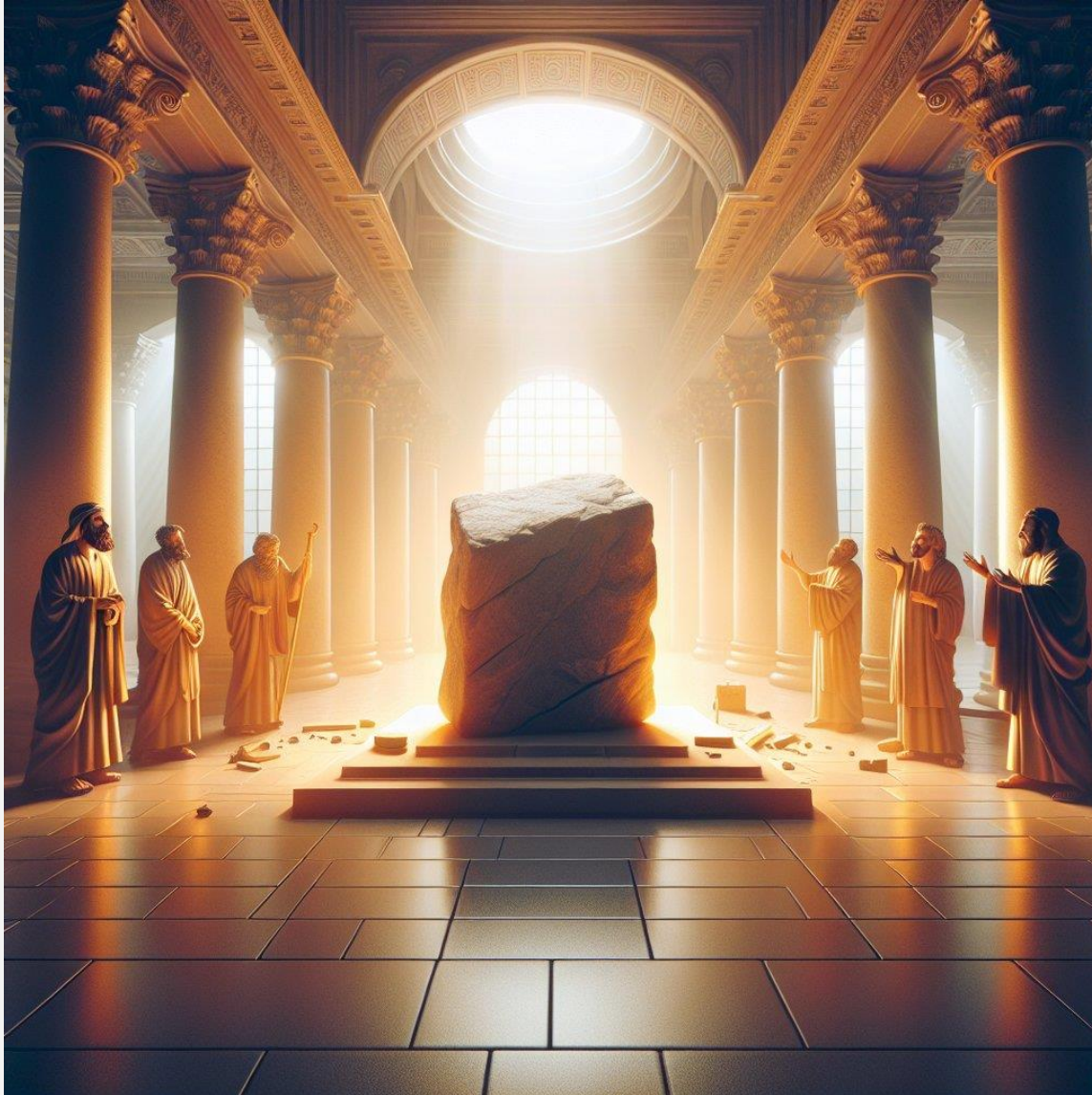
CORNERSTONES

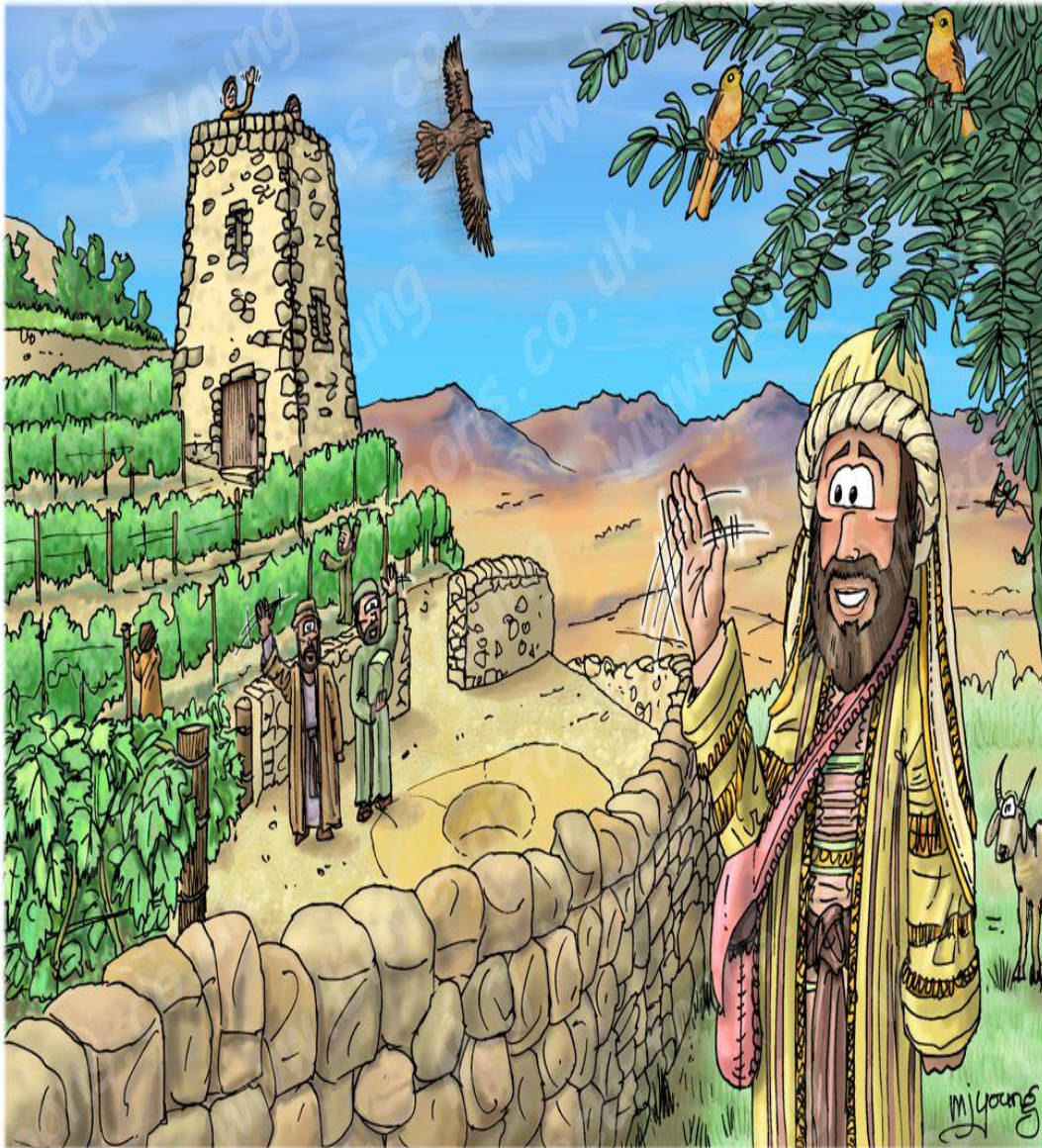

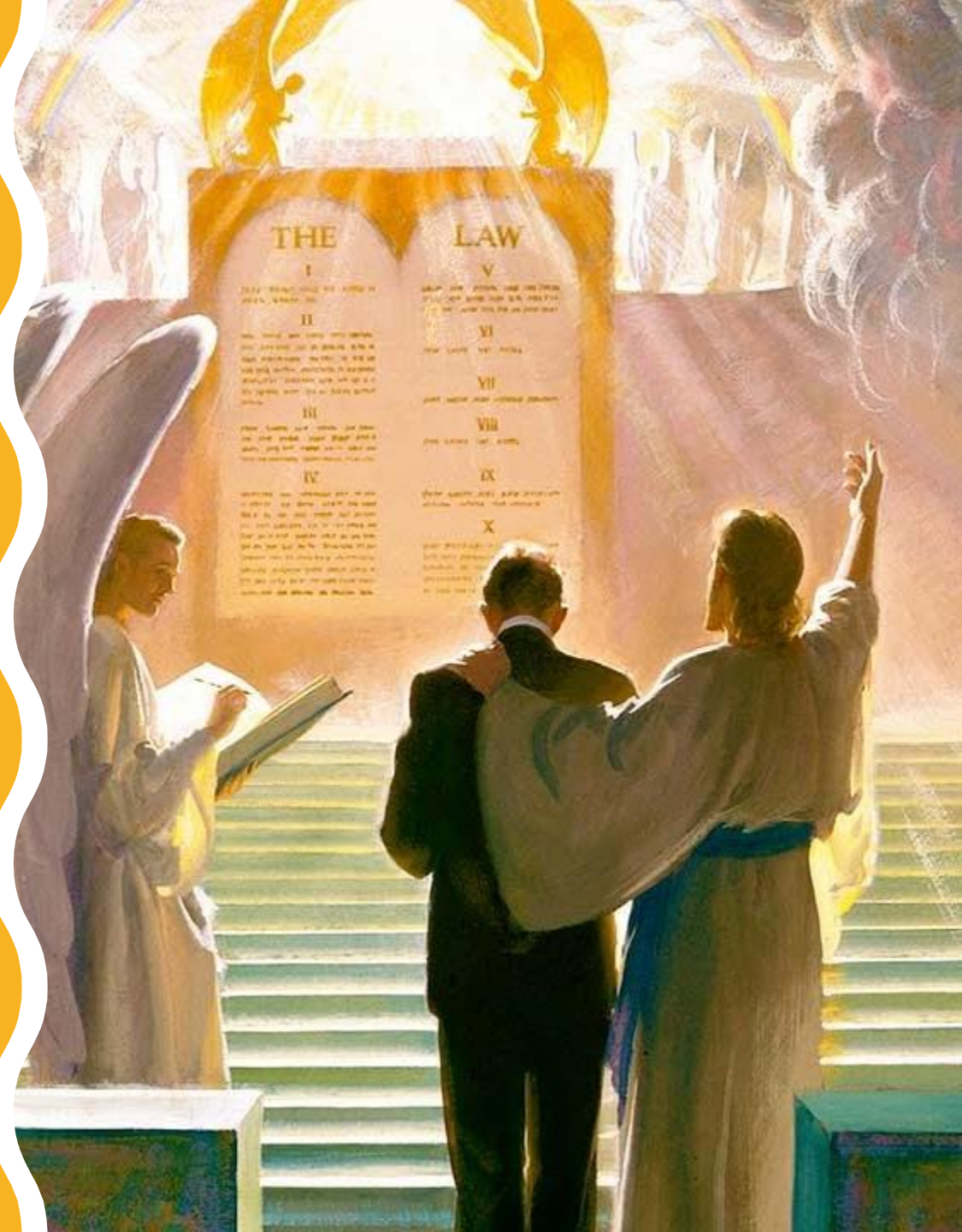
