WHY AUTHORITY FIRST?



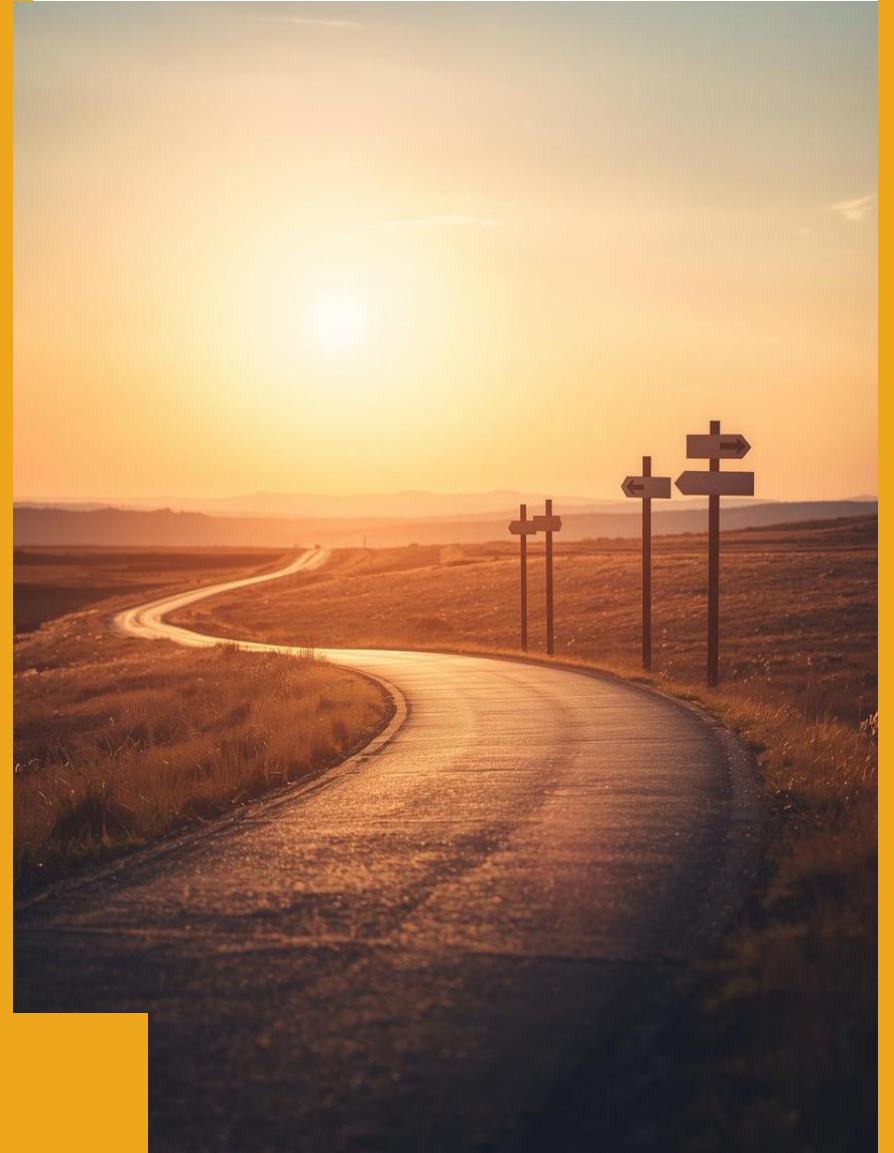


AMBASSADORS

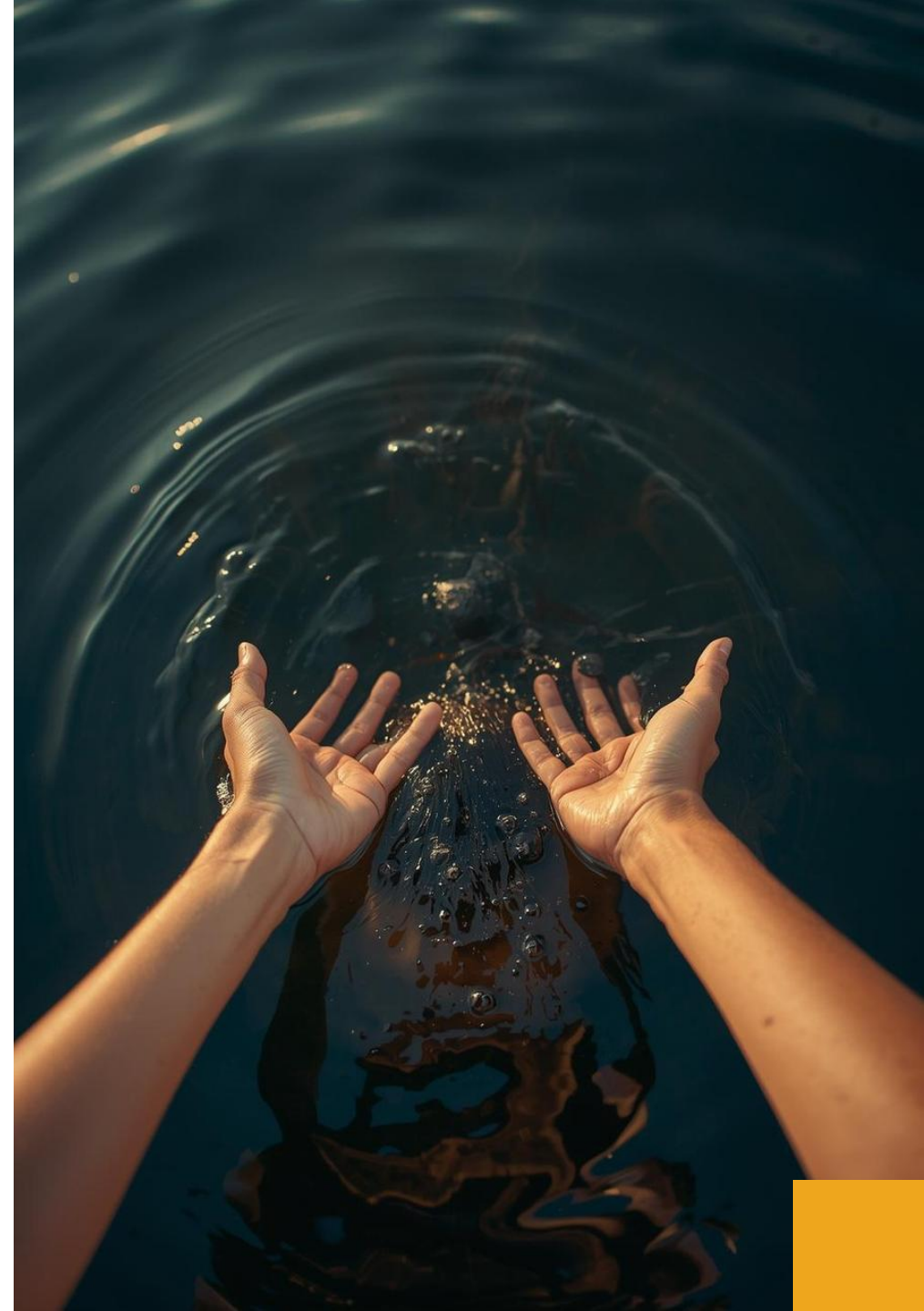

Overview of Two Defining Marks of a Disciple

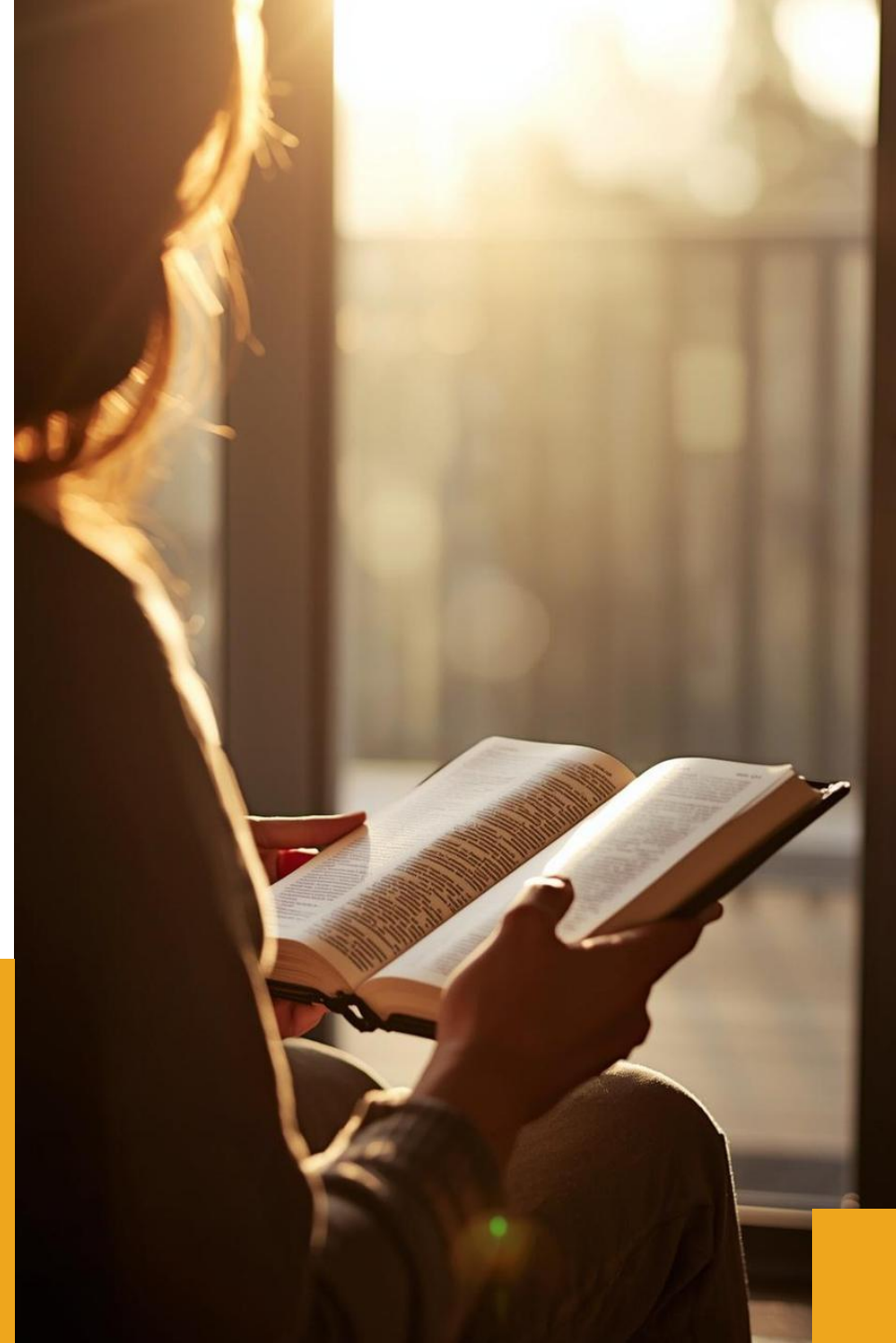
BELIEVING LEARNER

GENUINE DISCIPLE

Mathētēs alēthōs
— *the genuine*
disciple.



A person who places faith in Christ and follows in a life of learning. That is the disciple.

COMMAND CLARITY



The command is "make disciples," not "make converts." The focus is on depth of spiritual growth, not just decisions.

William Borden's Conviction


